

## Northwest ACTRA Finals 2025 Cattle Manager/Contractor Bid Sheet

## As Cattle Manager/Contractor you will be required to:

- Find, select, and provide quality roping cattle for approximately 2,500 runs
  - Location: Clark County Saddle Club Battle Ground, WA
  - Dates needed September 26-28, 2025
- All cattle must be sorted prior to the finals according to size and consistency
  - Multiple herds may be used.
- Cattle Manager/Contractor may acquire cattle from outside contractors.
  - o First consideration given to current ACTRA Arena Producers.
  - Subletting of cattle must be documented in writing and sent to nwactra@yahoo.com no later than 14 days prior to finals.
- Cattle Manager/Contractor will sort 30 head of cattle for all high team runs. These cattle should be sorted to provide the most even runs possible
- Cattle cut out of any roping during the Northwest ACTRA Finals, not sorted to another roping pen, may not be put back into the herd.
  - o A fine of \$100/head will be issued.
- Cattle Manager/Contractor will provide labor for arenas.
  - Includes head gate, pushing cattle up, stripping chute, cattle return, hand raking boxes as needed and cattle management.
  - Cattle Manager/Contractor designee must be present in arena.

## Cattle Bid to include:

- Mexican and/or Longhorn steers
- Average weight of 500 pounds
- Average horn size 10" to 12".
- Quality cattle for approximately 2,500 runs
  - o Cattle used to set the score (burn steers) are not counted as runs.
- Minimum of 250 head or more if ACTRA representatives feel it's necessary.
- Price per run should include all costs and expenses including-
  - Cattle, labor, electric eyes, management, liability, trucking, feed, and cattle manager costs.
  - o Furnish enough horn wraps for all cattle
